



MGA Re-Opening 'Conditions of Entry'

Melbourne Golf Academy is very pleased to announce we will reopen to the public from Tuesday 5th October at 8am. In line with the Victorian Government directives, our facility will open with the following conditions in place:

- **All patrons 16 years of age or older must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19**
 - Proof of full vaccination must be provided via the digital certificate accessed on your smartphone or a printed copy of your vaccination certificate issued by the Australian Government. If medical reasons prevent you from receiving any vaccinations, a signed medical certificate from your general practitioner must be provided to MGA staff.
- **Patrons must reside within a 15km radius of MGA**
- **Patrons must sign in via QR code**
- **Our venue capacity will be limited to 50 patrons**
 - This includes one (1) person per bay with no sharing or spectators watching on the driving range. Five (5) people on the short game area, and the putting green will remain closed.
- **Masks must be worn at all times in all areas**
- **Last balls will be sold no later than 7.30pm** and all patrons must exit MGA by 8.15pm due to curfew requirements
- **All transactions to be contactless (no cash)**
- **Our café will be closed;** however takeaway food and drinks will be available
